

COMMITMENT REQUIRED FOR THIS PROGRAM

The Muslim Leadership Program (MLP) is a mentoring program to support young Australian Muslims. It provides opportunities for Muslims to upskill in media engagement and communication, resilience, experience and to become the future leaders of the community.

If you are selected to be part of this program, it is extremely important that you commit to the program and schedule. There is a limited number of mentors available and therefore a space allocated to you is also a space taken away from others – so it's important you take full advantage of the program. The program is also being fully funded by ISRA (at no cost to the mentee) so it's important we ensure these funds – which are an 'amanah' (trust) are used effectively and fairly.

We understand exceptional circumstances can occur that are unexpected or entirely out of your control. If this happens, reach out to us to discuss options.

To successfully complete this program all mentees are required to:

Criteria to successfully complete program	Approx. Date	Requirement
Attend five training workshops	Saturdays or Sundays	Must attend (a minimum of 4 out of 5)
Attend kick-off night and closing night in person	9 th June / Nov	Must attend
Attend mentorship training (2-3hours)	18 th June	Must attend
Meet with mentor a minimum of four times (on separate, pre-scheduled occasions)	Scheduled by you	Must attend (a minimum of 4 meetings)
Successfully complete the mandatory project (will be media based, attend in person, details provided later)	Oct or Nov (TBC)	Must attend session
Complete one project that you will select from a list of options	Oct or Nov (TBC)	Must complete
